Please bring the following items to the event:

- Mortgage Statement
- 2012 & 2013 W-2 & tax return with all schedules
- Copy of rental agreement, if necessary
- 2 months of recent paystubs
- Budget of household expenses
- Documentation of other income
- 2 months of recent bank statements
- All Recent Utility Bills
- If you are self-employed, a Profit/Loss statement for the past 6 months

Don't worry if you do not have all the docs on the day of the event. You can still meet with a HUD-Certified counseling agency or your lender and get the process started.
