

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

This notice is an amendment to the earlier Public Notice published in the Daily Herald on June 7, 2026. As stated then, this notice is to advise citizens of their opportunity to review and comment on the draft Kane-Elgin Consortium (Kane County and the City of Elgin) 2026 Annual Action Plans. The draft plans contain projects proposed to be undertaken during Program Year 2026 (6/1/2026 - 5/31/2027) with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships Program funds provided by the U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development. Copies of the draft Kane County 2026 Annual Action Plan and the City of Elgin 2026 Annual Action Plan are available for review at the Kane County Development & Community Services Department (719 S. A 30-day public comment period runs from June 8 to July 7, 2026. Those wishing to submit written comments must do so by 11:59pm on Tuesday, July 7, 2026. This notice also advises citizens that the Kane-Elgin Consortium (Kane County and the City of Elgin) will hold a concurrent public hearing at 11:00am on Tuesday July 7, 2026. The public hearing will be held at both the Kane County Development & Community Services Department located at 719 S Batavia Avenue, Bldg. A, 1st Floor, Geneva, IL and at the Centre of Elgin, West Conference Room, 100 Symphony Way, Elgin, IL.

Following the public hearing and public comment period, the Annual Action Plan will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development with a summary of the comments received and the Consortium's responses to those comments.
