Randall Road over Tyler Creek Bridge Repairs Start August 6th

August 1, 2025 - Joint repair work on the Randall Road Bridge over Tyler Creek and the UP, CPKC, and IC&E Railroads is scheduled to begin Wednesday, August 6, 2025, and is expected to be completed by mid to late August, weather permitting.

To ensure worker safety, temporary lane closures will be in place in both the northbound and southbound lanes for the duration of the project. Crews will be working Monday through Saturday, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The project includes concrete removal, expansion joint repairs, polymer concrete placement, pavement patching, and silicone joint sealing.

The bridge will remain open to traffic, but lanes will be reduced to one lane in each direction during construction. Drivers should expect delays and are encouraged to allow extra travel time or use alternate routes when possible.
