Kane County Asphalt Rejuvenator Work Starts Sept. 2nd


August 27, 2025 - Kane County's Annual Asphalt Rejuvenator Program is scheduled to begin the week of September 2, 2025, weather permitting. The program applies an asphalt sealer and rejuvenator to roads that were resurfaced within the last year, helping extend the life of the pavement.

The process includes applying a rejuvenator liquid, allowing it to cure, placing sand on the treated roads for traction, and then sweeping up the excess material. This preventative maintenance reduces oxidation of the asphalt and prevents water from seeping in, protecting against freeze/thaw damage during the winter months.

Work will begin in the central part of the County and progress south over the course of four to five weeks, depending on weather conditions. Construction hours will be Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

During this time, roads will remain open but traffic will be reduced to one lane with the use of flaggers and temporary daily lane closures. Drivers are encouraged to use caution in the work zones, watch for crews and equipment, and avoid driving on the treated roadway until directed by flaggers.
