Kane County Clerk John A. Cunningham would like to extend his appreciation to the community partners who participated in the Clerk's **Voter Outreach Program (VOP)** during the March 17, 2026 Primary Election.

The VOP is a partnership between the Clerk's Office and Kane County businesses, schools, local governments, and community organizations with electronic or marquee signs in front of their locations. VOP participants display messages such as "Remember to Register to Vote," "Vote Early," or "Have you Voted," on their signage in the weeks prior to Election Day.

The Clerk's Voter Outreach Program has helped increase early voting and voter participation in recent elections. Approximately half of Kane County's voters now vote early, and with the community message reminders, voter turnout has also increased."
