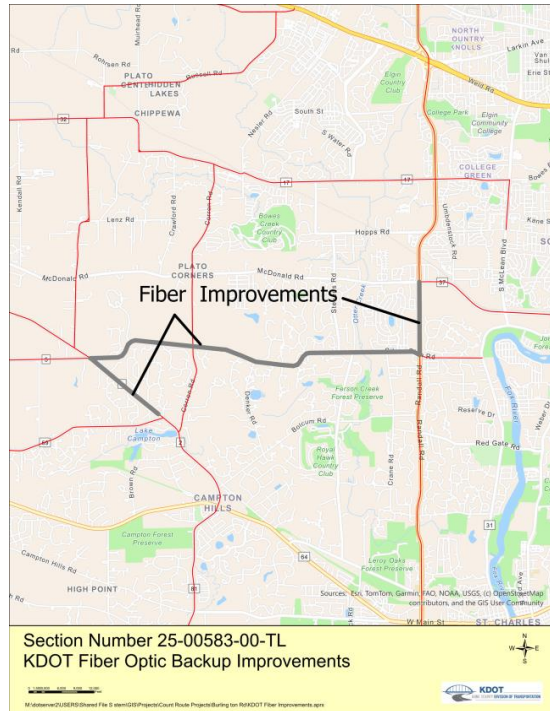
Fiber Optic Installation Work Scheduled Beginning April 6th

March 30, 2026 - Fiber optic utility installation work is scheduled to begin the week of April 6, 2026, weather permitting. The project includes installation of utility handholes and fiber conduit along Burlington Road, Silver Glen Road, and Randall Road.

This work will require the use of large, heavy equipment operating in or near the roadway shoulder and ditch line.

While these roadways will remain open to traffic, flaggers will be present as needed to assist with directing vehicles safely through the work zone. Work is expected to occur between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The project is anticipated to be completed by the end of May 2026, weather dependent.

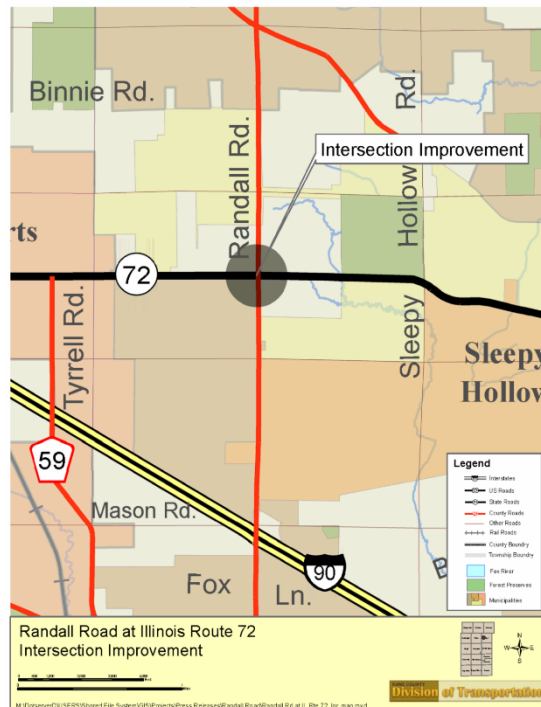
Intersection Improvements Scheduled at Randall Road and IL 72

February 11, 2026 - Intersection improvement work at the intersection of Randall Road and IL 72 is scheduled to begin the week of February 16th, weather permitting. The project includes the addition of a third through lane on both the northbound and southbound legs of Randall Road to increase capacity and improve safety at the intersection.

Additional improvements will include new multi-use paths along Randall Road, storm sewer installation, traffic signal modifications, intersection lighting, roadway resurfacing, and landscape restoration.

Randall Road and IL 72 will remain open to traffic; however, temporary daily lane closures will be necessary between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday. These closures are expected to impact traffic in the area. Flaggers will be present as needed to help direct vehicles safely through the work zone.

The project is anticipated to be completed by the end of December 2026, weather dependent.
