Kane County Government Operations Update for Extreme Cold on January 23, 2026

(1/22/26) Due to forecasted extreme cold weather on Friday, **January 23, 2026**, Kane County officials are encouraging residents to call ahead before visiting any Kane County government building in person.

Many non-emergency county operations will be conducted remotely to ensure the safety of the public and county employees. As a result, in-person services may be limited or unavailable, depending on the department or office.

Residents who need county services on **January 23, 2026** are advised to:

- **Contact the department in advance** to confirm office hours and service availability
- **Utilize online or remote service options** whenever possible

Additionally, all Kane County Courthouses will be physically closed, and court proceedings for the [16th Judicial Circuit Court](#) will be conducted remotely.
