Annual Spring Bird Count & the Health of Illinois' Birds

GENEVA, IL — Illinois' birds face a host of threats — from habitat loss, to global warming, pesticides, herbicides, and collisions with buildings. These perils have adversely affected the state's bird population, but how bad is the problem and what can we do about it?

Join John Sprovieri, president of Kane County Audubon, on Saturday, March 14, from 9:30-11 a.m. at the Barbara Belding Lodge in St. Charles, for a Learn from the Expert program "Promise or Peril? Annual Spring Bird Count & the Health of Illinois' Birds."

Sprovieri will discuss the spring bird count, a yearly census of Illinois' bird population conducted since 1972, what we've learned from the data, and how you can help.
