Tee-off is at 10 a.m., with golf expected to conclude around 3 p.m. Throughout the day, golfers can participate in a variety of complimentary contests, win prizes and support the Kane Forest Preserve Foundation's work throughout Kane County. Participants will also have the opportunity to win a vehicle with a hole-in-one at a designated hole sponsored by Bob Jass Chevrolet of Elburn. Beverage tickets will also be provided.

Proceeds from this year's Golf Outing will help fund the second and final phase of the Nature Play Space at LeRoy Oakes Forest Preserve in St. Charles. The project will create additional opportunities for children and families to explore, play and connect with nature through an engaging outdoor environment inspired by the surrounding landscape.
