The Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) is offering free **Spring 2025 Floodplain Management Webinars**—ideal for those new to the **National Flood Insurance Program** (**NFIP**) and a refresher for others.

Managed by **FEMA** and coordinated in Illinois by **IDNR/OWR**, the NFIP helps communities **reduce flood risks** and access **federal flood insurance**, **disaster assistance**, **and mitigation grants**. Participation requires adopting **local floodplain management regulations**.

Flooding is Illinois' most common natural disaster, causing nearly **\$700 million** in annual damages. Over **250,000 buildings** are in floodplains, and unwise development increases risks. Currently, **82 counties and 770 communities** participate in the NFIP.
