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Kane County Launches New Public Safety Alert System, Encourages Residents to Sign Up

Kane County is launching a new Public Safety Alert System and rolling out a countywide sign-up campaign to ensure residents receive fast, reliable information during emergencies—any time of day, year-round.

Kane County recently transitioned to a new mass notification vendor, Regroup, to enhance the delivery of public safety alerts and improve how residents receive critical information. The updated system replaces the county's previous vendor and offers expanded features, improved reliability and more flexibility for users.

The new Kane County Public Safety Alert System allows residents to choose how they receive alerts, including:

- Text message
- Phone call
- Email
- Mobile app notifications

Whether an emergency impacts the entire county or just a specific neighborhood, the system delivers timely, location-based information when it matters most.

Residents who enroll may receive real-time notifications about:

- Severe weather watches and warnings
- Hazardous materials incidents or gas leaks
- Large-scale police activity
- Evacuation or shelter-in-place orders
- Road closures and major traffic disruptions
- Other critical public safety updates

The Public Safety Alert System is managed by the Kane County Office of Emergency Management and powered by Regroup, a leading mass notification provider.
