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Self-Guided Nature Wellness Experience Coming to Kane County
Wandering With Wonder Launching Sept. 1

GENEVA, IL — The Kane Nature Rx Coalition is proud to share Wandering With Wonder, a self-guided nature wellness experience that allows people to connect with local places through their senses to benefit their mental, physical, and emotional health.

The self-guided Wandering With Wonder experience is launching at four local parks and forest preserves throughout Kane County, with accompanying audio that can be used anywhere there is sky above you and ground below you. Both the signage and audio are available in Spanish and English languages. Locations with Wandering with Wonder signage include:

- **Delnor Woods Park (St. Charles);** 0.5-mile loop, paved, ADA-accessible path; 200 Wing Ave., St. Charles, IL. Hours: dawn to dusk, year-round.
- **Hampshire Forest Preserve (Hampshire);** 1-mile loop, partially paved, partially mown grass; 44W880 Allen Rd., Hampshire, IL. Hours: dawn to dusk, road closed in winter.
- **Hawthorne Hill Nature Center (Elgin);** 0.75-mile loop, partially paved, partially woodchips, non-motorized all-terrain wheelchair available; 28 Brookside Dr., Elgin, IL. Hours: Dawn to dusk, year-round.
- **Oakhurst Forest Preserve (Aurora);** 1-mile loop, mown grass; 1650 Fifth Ave., Aurora, IL. Hours: Dawn to dusk, year-round.

Wandering with Wonder is designed to spark curiosity, creativity, and a sense of being present in the moment. Inspired by the practice of [forest therapy](#), this experience is a self-paced series of prompts that help you get in tune with nature's rhythms and connect to a place with your senses.
