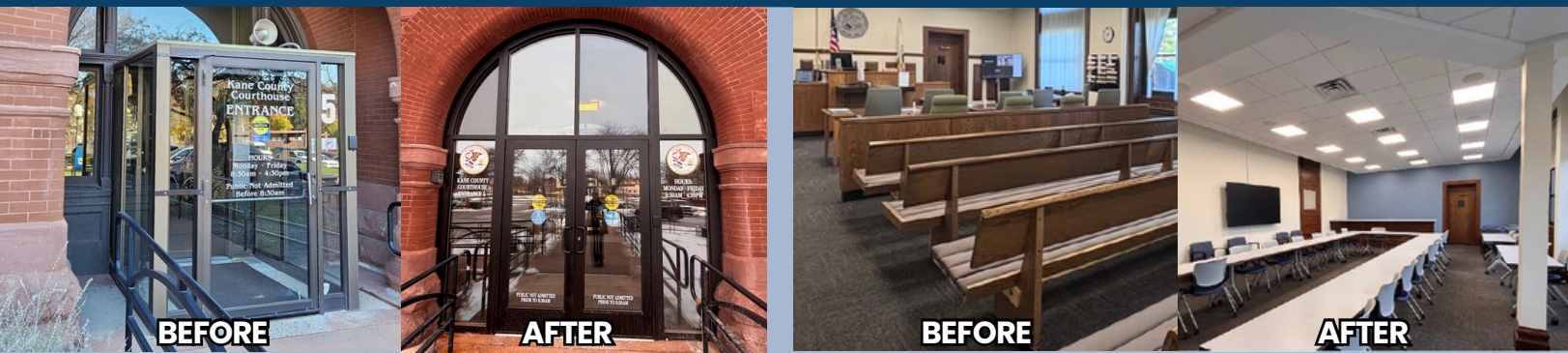


Kane County Building Management Monthly Brief

New Entrance and Jury Lounge for Kane County Courthouse

The Kane County Courthouse on Third Street in Geneva now has an enhanced ADA compliant back entrance, as well as a new jury lounge, making the Courthouse a more inclusive and welcoming environment for visitors and staff. New double doors replaced the old, single door back entrance for easier access. In addition, Courtroom 150 was renovated into a new ADA compliant jury lounge, enhancing the comfort and accessibility for jurors.
