# **New Security Lighting at the JC**

Staff and visitors to the Judicial Center (JC) have a new level of safety and security after the replacement of 118 obsolete and failing light poles that often left the campus dangerously underlit. The light poles and bollards feature energy efficient LED lighting that is much brighter when fully lit. New motion sensors also increase the lighting as someone approaches. This added security benefit can alert anyone to the presence of someone walking through the lot who would have otherwise gone unnoticed.

# Coming Up Soon - JC Paving!

Due to significant damage such as excessive cracking, surface wear and other structural issues, resurfacing of the Judicial Center parking lots will start this summer and finish before winter. The project will also include the repair of storm sewers that have collapsed, which if not addressed, will continue to cause flooding and damage to the jail. We will provide more details through signage at various campus entrances.
