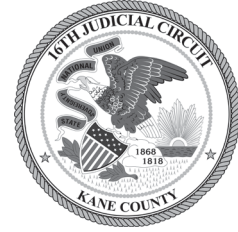


# Kane County Juvenile Justice Center Pre-Interview Questionnaire
